SAFETY INFORMATION

- NEVER use the charger with a defective power cord or damaged wires.
- NEVER place the output cable, power cord, or charger on a wet surface.
- NEVER obstruct the ventilation vents on the charger.
- NEVER use an off-board charger with the vehicle.
- NEVER use the charger in flammable or explosive environments.
- NEVER attempt to plug in the charger with wet hands or in extremely humid conditions.
- NEVER disassemble, repair, or modify the charger.
- ALWAYS unplug the charger from the AC outlet before maintenance or cleaning.
- ALWAYS plug and unplug the AC power cord by grasping the plug—DO NOT PULL THE CORD to avoid damage.
- ALWAYS store the charger indoors when not in use.
- ALWAYS place the charger in a clean and ventilated environment during operation.
- ALWAYS check the charging port for any obstruction or damage before plugging in the cord.


BEFORE YOU START Read this manual thoroughly before using the

charger. Improper use voids warranty and liability.

IMPORTANT

Ensure your scooter is turned off before charging.

First, ensure the two parts of the charger are connected securely. The wall AC plug should be connected to the charger box. The connection between the cable and box should feel firm with no wobble or play.

Proceed to plug the AC plug on the other end of the charger into a power outlet. Verify the voltage of the AC outlet matches the charger's requirements. The chargers can accept input voltage ranging from 100-240V, making them safe for use in most regions worldwide. Ensure you use the correct cable compatible with your local plug type to connect to the charger.

- Next, locate the charging port (in some scooters its located under a cap). Locate the round connector on one end of the charger, this is the end you must insert in the charging port. Then, gently insert the cable.
- If the battery is 100% full, the charger light will turn green. If the battery is not fully charged, the charger light will light up red. Once the light turns green, unplug the charger.

You will need to turn off the scooter before charging.

The battery pack comes with a built-in battery management system. This includes overcharging protection amongst other features, allowing your scooter to stay plugged in even after it is fully charged.

Please note that this applies to short periods of overcharging, such as the scooter being plugged in overnight. Please do not leave the scooter plugged in and charging for extended periods of time as it may result in battery damage or fire.
